

# Pack 350 Annual Father/Son Cake Bake 2009

## The Cake Bake rules are as follows:

1. Cakes must be made totally by the cub and father, uncle, grandfather, cousin, neighbor or another male helper, etc. NO FEMALE ASSISTANCE ALLOWED. If your father is unable to come to the pack meeting, bring your cake anyway.
2. All cakes must be baked at home prior to the meeting. It may be as large as you wish and can be either sheet or layer cake.
3. Boxed mixes may be used for all categories except Best Tasting. Best Tasting entries must be made from scratch and all frosting and decorations must be edible (best tasting entries only) such as lifesavers, candies, nuts, carrots, spaghetti, etc.... If you are not entering your cake in the Best Tasting category then you do not have to use only edible decorations.
4. You must return the CERTIFICATE OF WORKMANSHIP with your cake entry. Have your mom or kitchen supervisor fill it out, verifying that she did not help out in any way and that the kitchen was cleaned up afterwards.
5. Our theme will be determined by the vote of the Pack and will be announced at the October Pack meeting. Scouts are encouraged to design their cakes within this theme, however it is not required.



## Major Categories include:

- Best Tasting (see special requirements #3)
- Best themed cake (theme to be chosen by the Cub Scouts)
- Best sports cakes
- Best Cub Scout theme cake
- Biggest Cake
- Tallest Cake
- Smallest Cake
- Silliest cake
- Most colorful cake

(all boys will receive a certificate and we will "invent" a category for each boy to win)
